

# NOTICE TO INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS (Chiba-city residents)

## National Health Insurance premium reduction

The insurance premium of National Health Insurance (*Kokumin-Kenko-Hoken*) is decided depending on the insurance holder's income of the previous year. If your income is only from part-time jobs, you are likely to be granted a premium reduction. Scholarships are NOT counted as an income.

If you want to apply for the premium reduction, pick up the application form at ISD. We will also help you fill out the form since the form is prescribed in Japanese. (The form is also available at the ward office.)

Note that you should apply for the premium reduction between January and March every year.

Inquiries from those who live in other cities are also welcomed at ISD.
